Which is why I feel WHEN IT COMES TO POLITICAL ISSUES, there is one thing that literally "TRUMPS" everything, and helps us put life in its proper perspective... And it is the fact that the Bible tells us that we overcome the world—by OUR FAITH! And since we are all a part of this great university built by God, I have an idea, how about we start this thing off by burning all that POLITICAL nonsense in the FLAMES!!

Didn't see that coming did you? Just know that I am liable to use those torches a few more times throughout this speech just to keep y'all on your toes!

I would like to remind you that you are entering into a different world than I did after receiving my degree. The moral landscape of the world is quickly declining. That word is failure. I would be totally insincere if I did not remind you that somewhere along the line, no doubt, you will fail!

But know... failure is sometimes the cost of faith. Because TRUE faith is often very risky. A Sovereign God may even CAUSE you to fail in some sort of way. But I can assure you that it will not be for the sake of failure alone. Then what is he doing, you may ask yourself? He is preparing you for the next leg of your journey. He is teaching you, if you are willing to be taught. He is carving a CUSTOM path that can ONLY be followed by faith.

So don't allow yourself to lose heart, because failure can be one of two things for you— It can either be the end of something good, or the beginning of something even better! Faith makes failure the beginning of something better when you remember that faith is the substance of things hoped for and the evidence of things not seen! Know that God is always pleased to have more in store for those who choose to trust in Him. I'm a living witness of that fact!

Christian author, Robert C. Shannon writes...

It has been said that only man comprehends what he cannot see and believes what he cannot comprehend. Much of what we comprehend we cannot see: atoms, germs, love, hate, loyalty, sacrifice. He who lives by sight lives poorly indeed. Faith is learning to live by insight rather than by sight.

Let's reiterate one part! ***"Faith is learning to live by insight rather than by sight!"*** And there is no better source of insight into all of life, than the word of God!

Will you take me along when you are seeking—AND will you keep me when you find it?

Will you hold me as you knock on doors—AND will you bring in with when they open?

And finally, will you always endeavor to remind yourself that even a mustard seed of me is enough to uproot trees and move mountains like Jerry did?

In a nutshell... Will YOU have DYNAMIC FAITH? Very well then, I am happy to exist in you!

You see, I'm not asking you to be perfect, but I am asking you to believe in He who is! Trust me, it is your only hope of living the most fulfilling life you can! And let's be realistic folks! Who doesn't want to live that kind of life?

Well, I'm about to turn this thing back over to Rashad now. Thank you Rashad and everyone else in attendance for having me... Today, but most importantly, *FOREVER!* Rashad, the mic is yours! Don't hold us too much longer, because WE can't wait to get out there into that world!

Wow, Dynamic Faith, I must say it was a pleasure and an honor to hear from you! And.. I guess I don't have much longer. Give "Dynamic Faith" another round of applause everybody!!

Why I Chose To Speak On Faith

Now... Most would agree that college commencement speeches aren't exactly the most exciting things to sit through. But I trust WHAT Dynamic Faith and I were able to present gives substance to your hope and evidence of things yet unseen. Nevertheless commencement speeches aren't extremely important. But this one is! What you are doing today is infinitely bigger than a certificate or diploma! And there is nothing more important you can begin to do like never before with what you earned, than to pray! On Day 9 of Building Dynamic Faith, Dr. Falwell discusses executing your life plan. Here's what he writes: "I've discovered that if I plan my life on my knees, everything falls into place." Then he quoted St. Augustine who said, *"On your knees, pray as though it all depends on God; leave your knees and work as though it all depends on you."* How very true I have found that to be in my personal life and my professional career! I hope that you will forever KNOW and experience that value too!

7 Simple Thoughts...

So, in parting, I feel it is my duty to try to add value to your life, but to also leave with you something to mark this memorable occasion. Because to be quite honest with you, I don't exactly remember much of what my commencement speaker said. And after talking with friends and family, they can't even remember WHO their commencement speaker was!

I came into this thing DETERMINED that if you don't remember anything I said, though I believe that you will pick up a few nuggets, you definitely wont FOOORGET ME "yaaaaa boy" came with all this fire!! Hey, don't judge... We are the flames! Ain't no shame in our game!!

Finally, I will share with you "7 Simple Thoughts You'll One Day Be Glad You Remembered". I've had my graphics guy design a frameable printout that you can place in

They are simple—even to the point of being childlike. Yet, you still might not understand all of them right now. But I can promise you that they will be worth remembering. So here goes...

1. The exceeding abundant power that worketh in you rarely works unless you work too.
2. Itches that you create are usually the ones you don't want to be scratchin'. You can always make integrity your Tinactin.
3. Peter didn't sink beneath the waves by worrying about tomorrow. He was fearful about his next step—the next moment.
4. When trouble comes, remember: If God is not with you now, then He never was; which means that your problem is worse than you originally thought. But if He IS with you, then its even better than you think!
5. Forgiveness is not "for you first..." It is for God because He said that you have to.
6. Expressing love is more of a decision than a feeling. But when it is real, it will be felt in ways you can't fully explain.
7. Laugh at the right things a lot, sing joyful songs a whole lot, and develop your own happy dance and always look for reasons to use it!

We are called to be the salt of the earth. We are sent by Christ to bring the FLAAAAVOR (lil dance- swag) of God's righteousness to the world by living a particular way and sharing the gospel of Christ that makes sinners thirsty, for the water of LIFE, that only JESUS can give.

And you know what else is significant about salt? It does not burn in fire! In fact, Jesus even mentioned salt and fire in the same context when he said, "Everyone will be salted with fire, and every sacrifice will be salted with salt." Just know, in that context, he was even speaking of hell's torment for those who refuse to believe. Therefore they will be preserved in pain forever!

But unlike them, we are those who have been salted by GOD to WITHSTAND the day of His fiery wrath! And if we will not burn under God's wrath, then how much more are we to withstand the burning temptations of this fallen world!? "WE" ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH!

So remember, there is no need to over-complicate this thing called life. It is complicated enough. The power of simplicity is one of the most precious resources in life! Jesus led the simplest of lives, and yet he continues to impact the world like no other person who has ever walked the earth.
